

## Primary SMA Program - General Information for 2022

### When and Where?

“SMA A Class” = attend every “Odd” week of the term, starting Week 3 Term 1

“SMA B Class” = attend every “Even” week of the term, starting Week 4 Term 1

All parents will be notified of which weeks their student is to attend in due course.

Drop off: Between 8:30am and 8:45am

Pick up: 2:45pm

Where: The NVSHS back gate on Golden Wattle Drive

A Primary SMA staff member will wait with all students at the end of the day until 3 pm to ensure they are safe whilst waiting to be collected.

### What should students wear?

Students will wear their Primary SMA Shirt and regular school uniform shorts/skirt. If their Primary SMA shirt is not available, they are to wear their regular school uniform. They must wear their closed-in school shoes and socks.

### What should students bring?

**Equipment:** At the beginning of the year, students will need to bring each of the following items (they do not need to be named) to leave in the SMA classroom for the year.

- 2x Lead pencil
- 2x Blue or Black pen (year 6 only)
- 1x Red pen
- 1x Wooden 30cm ruler
- 1x Eraser

**Food/Drink:** Every week a hat, water bottle, fruit break, morning tea and lunch.

Students will have access to the canteen/tuckshop through pre ordering via the Flexi-schools App.

## What happens during the day?

Students will remain in the Primary SMA area and are not allowed to mingle amongst the high school student population. They will be supervised by an NVSHS Staff member at all times.

Students will complete specialist Science and Maths lessons across the day, depending on the year level they are in.

Morning Session: 8:45am – 11:00am (Fruit break at approx. 9:45am)

First break: 11:00am – 11:45am

Middle Session: 11:45am – 12:55pm

Second break: 12:55pm – 1:25pm

Afternoon Session: 1:25pm – 2:45pm

## What do students learn?

Students learn the same Science and Maths topics as detailed in the Australian Curriculum for their year level. We endeavour to inspire students in their learning with a greater depth of content and access to equipment for projects/experiments that they would not normally have access to.

Students will be assessed on what they have learnt at Primary SMA each term. Report cards will be sent home at the end of each Semester with Parent-Teacher interviews being offered at the beginning of Semester 2 in some capacity.

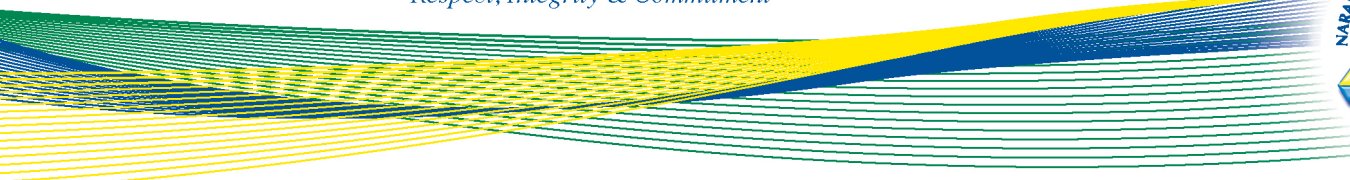
### What happens if my child has an excursion or special event on at their school?
