NARANGBA VALLEY STATE HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2022

(Ratified November 2021)

1. RATIONALE

The role of the school uniform at Narangba Valley State High School is central in establishing a community which shares a commitment to learning and in embedding a positive and inclusive school culture. It acts as a symbol that represents those who belong to our learning community, and provides the wider community with an image of a dedicated, proud and unified group working towards the common goals of Respect, Integrity and Commitment.

2. THE UNIFORM

The school uniform has been created by parents, students and teachers (and is P&C approved). The wearing of the correct school uniform is regarded very highly, as it determines the perception of the school held by the community and reflects school pride and discipline. **The formal uniform must be worn each Monday** and the sports uniform or formal uniform may be worn on other days. Formal uniform **MUST** be worn for all out of school excursions, formal events and non-sporting competitions.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL UNIFORM ITEMS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SOCKS AND SHOES MUST BE PURCHASED FROM THE SCHOOL UNIFORM OUTLET.

JUNIOR UNIFORM (Years 7, 8 & 9)

Formal Uniform – Worn every Monday (and any other day) and for formal school events

- Formal blue school blouse and navy junior school tie worn with formal navy skirt or formal navy shorts or tailored navy slacks.
- Formal blue school shirt worn with formal navy shorts or tailored navy trousers.
- Plain white socks, visible above the ankle
- Lace-up shoes or joggers (plain black leather / nonporous- refer to the school's footwear guide)
- NVSHS navy blue bucket hat – reversible with house colours (school branded hat is not compulsory, but a hat is to be worn for all outside activities as per our sun safety policy)

NB – NVSHS Track pants do not form part of Formal uniform

Sports Uniform – May be worn Tuesday to Friday

- Junior school polo shirt
- Unisex navy NVSHS shorts or formal school shorts
- Unisex NVSHS track pants
- Plain white socks, visible above the ankle
- Black lace up shoes or joggers (plain black leather / non-porous- refer to the school's footwear guide)
- NVSHS navy blue bucket hat – reversible with house colours (school branded hat is not compulsory, but a hat is to be worn for all outside activities as per our sun safety policy)

WINTER UNIFORM (ALL YEAR LEVELS)

- NVSHS fleecy jumper
- NVSHS knit cardigan
- NVSHS knit pull-over
- NVSHS zipper jacket
- NVSHS track pant
- NVSHS scarf

PROGRAM UNIFORMS

IN ADDITION TO THE COMPULSORY UNIFORM LISTED, STUDENTS INVOLVED IN SPECIALTY PROGRAMS NEED TO PURCHASE THE RELEVANT COMPULSORY UNIFORMS FOR THEIR PROGRAM.

Trade Training Centre (Year 11 only worn on allocated Trade Training Centre days)

- Navy long sleeve cotton drill shirt (must have NETWORKS logo)
- Navy cotton drill cargo pants (must have NETWORKS logo)
- Leather steel cap safety boots

Science Maths Academy (SMA)

- SMA polo shirt
- SMA formal tie
- SMA fleecy jumper

NVSHS Sports Academy

SENIOR UNIFORM (Years 10, 11 & 12)

Formal Uniform – Worn every Monday (and any other day) and for formal school events

- Formal white school blouse and tie worn with formal navy school skirt or formal navy shorts or tailored navy slacks
- Formal white school shirt worn with formal navy shorts or tailored navy trousers. Senior tie to be worn with uniform in Term 2 and 3 only.
- Plain white socks, visible above the ankle
- Black lace-up shoes or joggers (plain black leather / non-porous- refer to the school's footwear guide)
- NVSHS navy blue bucket hat – reversible with house colours (school branded hat is not compulsory, but a hat is to be worn for all outside activities as per our sun safety policy)

NB – NVSHS Track pants do not form part of Formal uniform

Sports Uniform – May be worn Tuesday to Friday

- Senior school polo shirt
- Unisex navy NVSHS shorts or formal shorts
- Unisex NVSHS track pants
- Plain white socks, visible above the ankle
- Lace up shoes (plain black leather / nonporous)
- NVSHS navy blue bucket hat – reversible with house colours (school branded hat is not compulsory, but a hat is to be worn for all outside activities as per our sun safety policy)

Netball

- Narangba Valley Netball Nova's academy dress shirt

AFL

- Narangba Valley Vipers AFL dress shirt

NON-COMPULSORY UNIFORMS

NVSHS Senior Jersey (Year 12 only)

- Purchase of a NVSHS Senior Jersey is available to eligible students only
- Senior Jersey design, including name on back of jersey, subject to approval by the Deputy Principal
- Uniform shirt must be worn under senior jersey at all times

THE FOLLOWING ALSO APPLIES TO THE WEARING OF THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Uniform must be worn under winter uniform at all times.
- NVSHS pullover, cardigan, fleecy jumper, zipper jacket & scarf can be worn with formal or sports uniform.
- NVSHS track pants can only be worn with sports uniform. Track pants are not to be rolled up.
- Denim jeans / cargo pants / beanies / bandannas / non NVSHS scarves are not acceptable
- Sockettes/ socks below the ankle are not acceptable
- No visible undershirts are to be worn
- Caps must be worn correctly, not back to front or sideways
- Sleeves, cuffs and pants are not to be rolled up
- Black shoe laces only
- Tattoos – if present, must be covered at all times
- Tights are not to be worn with shorts
- Steel cap safety boots are NOT permitted to be worn outside of Senior timetabled workshop classes. Normal school shoes must be worn to school, and are to be worn for all other classes and during breaks.

JEWELLERY

The wearing of jewellery is limited to:

- One pair of either small sleepers or studs allowed in ears (no hoops or dangling items)
- One nostril piercing allowed with one small metal (gold or silver) nose stud no larger than 2mm permitted. Nose hoops, rings and barbells are not permitted
- Additional facial piercings must contain clear studs, covered by tape or be removed
- One Watch
- One small, flat signet ring

The wearing of any additional jewellery (e.g. necklaces, bracelets and anklets) is not permitted.

MAKE-UP/ NAIL COLOUR/ HAIR COLOUR

The wearing of unnatural and colourful make-up, nail polish or hair colour does not form part of the NVSHS uniform and must not be worn.

- Makeup must be natural looking, with no heavy use of eye shadow, eye liner or mascara
- Clear/nude coloured nail polish
- False eye lashes are not permitted.
- Students hair must be of a natural colour (no unnatural coloured dye e.g. blue, pink, green, bright red). Hair must not be styled in any extreme manner e.g. with the use of gel, mousse or hair putty etc.)

3. PROCEDURES FOR INFRINGEMENTS

UNIFORM

For students wearing incorrect shoes or incorrect uniforms the following applies;

- Students are required to present a note to the uniform shop before school, and change into the correct uniform (no penalty recorded)
- If a student presents to class in the incorrect uniform, the infringement will be documented. The student will have to change into correct shoes or uniform from the school uniform bank. If the student has no note they will receive a lunch time detention. (They will still be expected to change)
- Any student who refuses to change into loan stock will have a parent contacted to collect them from school. If a parent is unable to be contacted and or collect their child they will be withdrawn to the Behaviour Support Unit.

JEWELLERY/MAKEUP/ NAIL COLOUR/ HAIR COLOUR

- Students will be required to remove any jewellery not permitted. Repeat offenders will have their jewellery handed in to Student Services and referred in line with the school's Student Code of Conduct
- Students wearing additional non-clear facial piercings will be required to tape or remove them. Repeated request to cover and remove will be referred in line with the school's Student Code of Conduct
- Student wearing unacceptable makeup and nail polish will be sent to Student Services for removal. Repeat offenders will be referred in line with the school's Student Code of Conduct
- Student's with non-natural hair colour will be sent to speak to their House DP

Students who repeatedly fail to adhere to this school policy may face disciplinary action in line with the school's Student Code of Conduct and lose privileges like NVP, ability to wear a senior jersey, attend the formal/graduation, represent the school in events or face other disciplinary action.

FOOTWEAR GUIDE

Black Leather Lace up / Velcro Shoes or Joggers
(Plain / non-porous)

Black Soles/Black Shoelaces, White socks visible above the ankle



The following are NOT acceptable



Canvas or fabric shoes
Ballet Flats / Backless or open toe shoes / Slip on shoes
Shoes with coloured sections or highlights of colour
Shoes with coloured laces
Shoes not entirely black

Socks – Plain White, visible above the ankle
