This funding will be used to


- Achieve an overall attendance rate of 92%.
- Improve NAPLAN mean scale scores in Numeracy, Reading and Writing.
- Increase the percentage of students within the Upper Two Bands (U2B) of NAPLAN in Reading and in Numeracy.

Our initiatives include

- A focus on improving attendance rates.
- Embedding whole school strategies to improve literacy and numeracy through targeted professional development and use of literacy and numeracy coaches.
- Implementing various extension programs to increase the percentage of students in the U2B.
- Identifying students and creating targeted intervention classes for those currently below/near nation minimum benchmarks in reading and numeracy.
- Continuing to embed ASoT as our Pedagogical Framework, using coaches to build teacher expertise and provide professional targeted feedback.
- A focus on effective use of BYOx devices in classroom teaching to improve engagement and maximise outcomes.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Analysing student literacy/numeracy levels and creating targeted intervention classes (NMS students) or extension activities (U2B students).	209,700
Funding coaches to deliver targeted professional development for staff.	185,000
Allocating time for English/Maths co-ordinators to review and refine curriculum and support staff in their respective year level.	150,000
Purchasing IT resources to support literacy/numeracy development and to build teacher capability.	75,000
