Fashion explores what underpins fashion culture, technology and design.

Students use their imaginations to create, innovate and express themselves and their ideas, and to design and produce design solutions in a range of fashion contexts.

This course consists of 3 lessons per week and includes integrated practical and theory elements. Students are required to participate in ALL aspects of the 2 year course.



Practical



Throughout Year 11 and 12, students will experience a range of practical tasks, both in weekly lessons as well as for assessment:

- Accessory Design & Construction
- Merchandising
- Textile and Fabric Manipulation
