#### This funding will be used to

- Increase whole school attendance | 92% and 30% school cohort <85%
- Increase attendance, engagement and achievement for students identified as amber and red zone
- Increase the percentage of students within Upper Two Bands(U2B) in Reading and Numeracy
- Enhance teacher pedagogy | Guaranteed curriculum, data informed practices, embedded literacy and numeracy in context and technologically based learning pedagogies
- Enhance school culture and House structure to increase belonging and social emotional competence

#### Our initiatives include

- Attendance | Enhance Attendance Team to provide timely support and intervention for disengaged learners
- **Support and Intervention** | Continue to support amber and red zone students through the Behaviour Support Unit and Student Hub
- **Achievement** | Continue the implementation of extension programs in Mathematics, English and the Science Maths Academy (SMA) to increase the percentage of students in the U2B.
- **Teaching** | Professional learning for teachers in the school focus areas: pedagogy, aligned curriculum, literacy and numeracy, data informed practice and technologically based learning pedagogies
- School Culture | Increase enrichment opportunities for students to enhance their health and wellbeing, connection to school and connection to peers

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional staff to:
  - o Increase school culture, student belonging and attendance
  - o Enhance targeted support for red and amber zone students
  - o Create the flexispace and flexispace program for disengaged learners
  - Support and extend U2B students
    - (\$559,786)
- Developing staff capacity through releasing staff for PD, coaching conversations and data analysis conversations (\$35,000)
- Enhance external spaces and increase enrichment opportunities to build school culture, inclusion and belonging (\$50,000)
