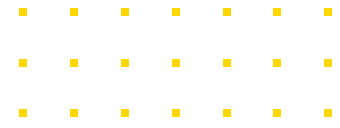

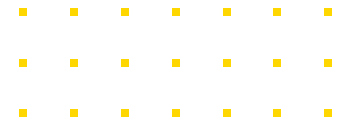
NORMS

Uniforms

The school uniform policy must be followed at all times:

- Formal uniform is compulsory every Monday, but students can choose to wear it any other day if they so wish.
- The sports uniform can be worn Tuesday to Friday.
- Shoes MUST be plain black & non-porous. (Leather or synthetic uppers). They must be fully enclosed.
- Socks are to be plain white or black and be clearly visible above the shoe.

If a student is out of uniform, they will be required to change into a loan uniform issued by the school. This includes shoes. Detentions will be issued if the school has not been notified.
